

YOU decide how much you'd like to donate each pay period, and we will automatically deduct it from your paycheck.

## Frequently Asked Questions

**How do I sign up?** Log on to Infor, look for “Employee Giving” and select “YNHH Positive Difference.” From there you will be taken to ESS and prompted through a few quick steps to establish your biweekly contribution. Each pay period, that amount will be automatically deducted from your paycheck.



**Will my gift really make a difference?** Absolutely. Even \$2 per pay period (that’s the minimum required) adds up to a significant amount over the course of an entire year—that’s the beauty of donating through automatic payroll deduction. And if you can give more, the difference you make will be even more meaningful!

### Can I choose how YNHH uses my donation?

Yes! You can choose to direct your gift to one of the areas listed on the right. Or split your gift among any number of areas—as long as you designate at least \$2 per pay period to each one. The Positive Difference page in ESS explains how.



**What if I want to make a change or increase my contribution after I’ve enrolled?** No problem. Simply log on to ESS and follow the prompts for the change you wish to make.

When you are done, Payroll is alerted to make the change.

**How much of my gift goes to the area(s) I designate?** 100%! Every single penny of your gift goes directly to the area(s) you choose. Unlike some nonprofit organizations that retain a portion



of every gift to cover overhead expenses, your entire donation will be used to benefit patients.

**Can I make a one-time gift by credit card or check instead?** Of course. Just log on to [givetoynhh.org/positivedifference](http://givetoynhh.org/positivedifference) to make a donation using your credit card, call **203-688-9644**, or send a check to the address on the back of this brochure.

### When should I donate—is there a deadline?

Do it right away—while you’re thinking of it! But if you can’t do it immediately, please be sure to enroll through ESS no later than September 30, 2021. Payroll deductions will begin the first pay period after you enroll.

## Choose from one or more of these areas



- **Adult Psychiatric Services Patient Care**  
For recreational, educational, and therapeutic patient services and patient care needs.
- **Center for Musculoskeletal Care Patient Wellness & Education**  
For patients living with bone, joint, spine, and movement disorders such as multiple sclerosis and Parkinson’s disease.
- **Closer to Free Fund**  
For patient care programs and services, clinical research, technology, and equipment within Smilow.
- **Employee Hardship**  
Financial assistance for YNHH employees who experience an unexpected emergency that results in a severe, temporary financial hardship.
- **Heart and Vascular Patient Care**  
For heart and vascular patient and family education and patient care services within the YNHH Heart & Vascular Center.
- **Integrative Medicine Services**  
For alternative therapies and services such as Reiki, yoga, aromatherapy, therapeutic massage, guided imagery, and art expression.
- **Oncology Social Work**  
For financial assistance to oncology patients and their families for items such as meals, parking, wigs, transportation, and prescriptions.
- **Sickle Cell Program Fund**  
For program support including patient care needs, education and patient related expenses such as parking, meals and transportation.
- **Transplantation Center Patient Care**  
For patient and staff education, patient care services, and research activities at YNHH Transplantation Center. (liver, kidney, and pancreas)
- **YNHCH Family Resource Center**  
For families of pediatric patients: access to computers, cell phone chargers, coffee, and educational resources related to children’s health.
- **The Fund for Yale New Haven**  
For areas of greatest need throughout the hospital.
- **The Fund for Yale New Haven Children’s Hospital**  
For areas of greatest need in the children’s hospital.
- **The YNHH St. Raphael Campus Fund**  
For areas of greatest need on the St. Raphael Campus.
